This product is shipped in good condition. Surfaces needing aggressive cleaning methods indicate product neglect or abuse. Improper cleaning may cause irreparable damage such as crazing, cracking, blister, de-lamination or other permanent damage that may not be immediately visible.

**DO NOT APPLY TAPE, STICKERS, FILMS, SIGNAGE, ETC TO SURFACES!**

- Do not clean in direct sunlight
- Do not use abrasive cleaners
- Do not use metal scrapers, razor blades, or putty knives
- Do not use petroleum-based solvents, acetone, MEK or other solvents

The following procedures are sufficient to satisfactorily clean properly installed and maintained product. Before cleaning commences the surface to be cleaned should be examined and be free of damage, paint, mortar, plaster etc. If not, a condition report and damage waiver should be obtained from General Contractor or authority having jurisdiction before proceeding

- ✓ Flush surface with clean water to remove loose debris.
- ✓ Uniformly apply a mild detergent / water solution using Joy, or Palmolive detergent to the surface using soft, clean, cloth or similar applicator.
- ✓ Change / rinse cleaning cloths/ applicators regularly.
- ✓ Use extreme care to avoid trapping debris, sand, metal or any type foreign particles against the surface.
- ✓ Flush with clean water and dry surface, gaskets, sealants, and framing with soft flannel or cotton cloth to avoid potential deterioration or staining.

**Examine surface for visible damage from cleaning before proceeding!**

### **Cleaning Glass Clad Polycarbonate Bullet Resistant glass**

Glass clad polycarbonate ballistic glass can be permanently damaged if improperly cleaned. To clean first blow dust off the surface you intend to clean and then use a mild solution of soapy water by applying to surface with a microfiber cloth. Rinse with clean water. Keep excess liquid from going into window frames. Remove excess liquid using a flannel, microfiber or cotton cloth. Do not allow cleaning solutions to stay on windows for a long duration. Cleaning should be done only as needed to limit accidental exposure, streaking or damage to the windows. Cleaning of adjacent materials such as but not limited to: window frames, counter tops, wall panels, ceiling panels, and door hardware must use similar process & materials to avoid exposure from incompatible materials. Assume materials are not compatible unless they have been approved by the ballistic glass manufacturer.

#### **Compatible Cleaners & Detergents:**

Joy (Recommended 1 ml Joy to 1L clean water)

Palmolive (Recommended 1 ml Palmolive to 1L clean water)

Isopropyl Alcohol (50-99% concentration, diluted with clean water)
